BUZZ BRINGS \$96,000 PICK 6 HOME FOR CUSTOMER

Horse Player NOW handicapper James Dickson made a long-distance friend Sunday when BUZZ subscriber Michael Beychok utilized Dickson's longshot know-how in taking down \$96,982.20 in Santa Anita's pick six pool. Now, the two get to share their stories when they meet face-to-face later this month in the DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship as both are national qualifiers.

Dickson tabbed Sunday's lone price in the pick six with BUZZ three-star special Pretty Kinzie, who won Leg B at 13.90-1 odds. The \$29.80 winner was the only large return in the entire sequence, joined by winners at 2-1, 5-2, 3-1, 3-1, and 5-1. If you found Pretty Kinzie, like Dickson did, you were one of a handful of live tickets in the pool that totaled more than \$800,000.

Here's what Beychok, of Baton Rouge, La., wrote to us after his \$96,982.20 score:

"Thanks to Horse Player NOW and the two Santa Anita picks today, I hit the pick 6. I would never have had it without Pretty Kinzie. Now, if Pack Your Bags would have won (9-1 Race 4 BUZZ play and eventual runner-up by a neck), I might have won the whole thing! Anyway, tell Dickson he drinks and eats for free in Vegas at the NHC."

Sunday's BUZZ report, which compiles the Horse Player NOW team of national handicappers' coast-to-coast horses to watch for each racing day, noted:

Race 5 – SA

#3 *Pretty Kinzie* (ML unavailable) 🍀🍀🍀

Our Eyes: One more shot for this girl, as she drops again to a softer level and will hopefully sit in a better spot in the early stages here than her last few. Has tried dueling and closing, but I think she's best held just off the pace-setters, and then getting first run in the lane. – James Dickson

As you can see from the Daily Racing Form chart (<http://www1.drf.com/drfPDFChartRacesIndexAction.do?TRK=SA&CTY=USA&DATE=20110102&RN=99>), Pretty Kinzie got the golden trip Dickson hoped for, and customers like Beychok were on their way to a golden payday.

The 13-1 assist in the pick 6 capped a spectacular week for the BUZZ report, which also included Fair Grounds handicapper Brian Spencer unloading a 40-1 winner on Thursday, Daisy Devine, who paid \$82.20 as the longest shot on the toteboard. She was rising in class off this maiden claiming score evaluated by Spencer:

"Inside off honest splits, waited slightly turning for home, between runners, advancing in lane, switched out & into top gear, easily best in professional score."
